### Building Contractor Tips

- The lowest cost, energy-saving solution for buildings is insulation. Heating Ventilation, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration (HVAC&R) contractors should consider joining the local ASHRAE chapter to share best practices: [www.ashrae.org](http://www.ashrae.org)
- ENERGY STAR and LEED building practices can increase your profitability, increase customer satisfaction, increase tenant retention, and improve project performance. Visit <http://oee.nrcan.gc.ca/english> or [www.cagbc.org](http://www.cagbc.org) for more information.
- Set up a construction demolition process at your site to reduce costs, manage compliance issues, create marketing opportunities, obtain certification, and reduce environmental impacts.
- Deconstruction – instead of demolition - creates jobs, salvages material for reuse and reduces waste sent to landfills/incinerators. Construction and demolition waste accounts for 25% of Canada's non-hazardous waste stream going to landfills.
- Implement green building technologies such as recycling gray water, installing dual flush toilets, and using hot water recovery systems to reduce water use and save clients money on their energy bills.
- Build with recycled products whenever possible and choose low VOC paints.

- Purchase certified, sustainable construction materials such as FSC plywood, ENERGY STAR windows and doors.

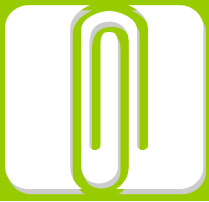
