



# Greening To-Do List

## Small Retail Businesses

### Lighting

- On average, 25% of an organization's electricity costs come from lighting. Make your lighting more energy efficient to reduce these costs by up to a third, reduce your carbon footprint and improve the work environment.
- Change incandescent bulbs to compact florescent bulbs and change T12 tubes to T8s or T5s.
- Switch lights off in empty rooms or install occupancy sensors.
- Open the blinds to take advantage of natural light.

### Equipment

- Set refrigeration at the right temperature — even 1°C lower than needed can raise your costs by 2-4%.
- Buy ENERGY-STAR equipment and think about switching from PCs to laptops. Laptops use about 10% of the energy of a standard PC.
- Use a timer or a Smart Strip power bar to turn off machines that no one is using.

### Other Conservation Measures

- Set refrigeration at the right temperature — even 1°C lower than needed can raise your costs by 2-4%.
- Buy ENERGY-STAR equipment and think about switching from PCs to laptops. Laptops use about 10% of the energy of a standard PC.
